

# The Revelation I Received About **TRUE**Worship.



Acts 7:31, "When Moses saw it, he wondered at the sight: and as he drew near to behold it, the voice of the LORD came unto him"

**Note**: Word breakdown on slides 5 and 6.

Exodus 3:2-4, "And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed. (3) And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt. (4) And when the LORD saw that he turned aside, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here am I."

KJV Version.

"to inquire or admire"

Acts 7:31, "When Moses saw it, he wondered at the sight: and as he drew near to behold it, the voice of the LORD came unto him"

\*\*KJV Version.\*\*

"to get close"

"to consider attentively, fix one's eyes or mind upon."

"mighty appearance"

"to cause to turn aside, cause to depart, remove, take away, put away, depose, avoid"

Exodus 3:3-4, "And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt.

(4) And when the LORD saw that he turned aside, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here am I."

Acts 7:31 and Exodus 3:2-4 are examples of what we should do in our INTIMATE relationship with The I AM. Now that I have broken down The Word, let's put it into "layman's terms":

We are supposed to admire and inquire of the presence of The Most High. Once this happens, we should get closer and become INTIMATE with The I AM. THEN He Speaks. Wondering and drawing near to Him is a form of worship. Then The Consuming Fire will commune with you. You will feel the presence of The Almighty I AM.

But remember, you have to "**turn aside**". Depart from any distractions that are causing you to depart from the presence of The I AM.

"he wondered" Moses INQUIRED of the burning bush and ADMIRED the sight of it. Personally, I love to compliment The Most High (i.e. "You're Marvelous!"; "You're Beautiful!"; "You're Holy!" etc.)

Then "he drew near to behold it". He got CLOSER (or as we would say "intimate" which means "to know" [Yada H3045]). Not only did he draw close but he BEHELD it or attentively fixed his eyes and mind upon the burning bush.

**THEN** it says, "the voice of the LORD" came unto Him.

This is like a step by step process of properly worshipping The Most High. I summed it up in *Three A's*:

#### **Admire**

the Glory and Beauty of The Most High.

**Aspire** (desire or pursue)

to be in His presence and not only be in it, but to be permeated (filled) by it.

#### **Afire**



allow The Consuming Fire to come set you afire (*Exodus 24:17*) as He communes with you.

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
