HOW TO RECEIVE GOD'S FORGIVENESS?

Psalm 32:1, "Blessed is he who transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered." KJV Version.

-KING DAVID

HOW DO I APPROACH GOD?

Firstly, you need to know WHO you are approaching. You are approaching The God who sent His only begotten Son, Jesus Christ, to die for your transgressions. It is through His sacrifices, His Blood that your sins may be atoned for. Start by acknowledging THIS God & what HE has done for you.

WHAT MOVES GOD TO FORGIVE ME?

Are you ready for the answer? It's so simple. Humility. Brokenness. & Contrition. These 3 things move The I AM to listen to your petition for forgiveness. These 3 things are a sweet, pleasant, and delightful aroma to God's Heavenly Nostrils. These 3 things attract and draw God to hear you.

WHAT MOVES GOD TO FORGIVE ME?

Psalms 51:17, "The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou will not despise." KJV Version. James 4:6, "But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble." KJV Version. Do you see? He values humility,

brokenness, & contrition.

THE 3-STEP PROCESS

Number I- Acknowledge & Confess Your Sins. You need to address that what you're doing is labeled as a sin. "How do I find out?" Go to The Word of God. Admit to the Father you're a sinner or that you've sinned. Admit that you have done wickedness in the sight of the Lord & transgressed against His perfect laws.

THE 3-STEP PROCESS

Number 2-Ask for His Forgiveness. A simple, "Dear Heavenly Father, I'm coming before You asking for Your forgiveness. Only You can forgive me of my transgressions. Allow them to be washed away in the blood of Jesus Christ. Have mercy on me, oh God! Cleanse & renew me! Forgive me, Lord!" & He will!

THE 3-STEP PROCESS

Number 3- REPENTANCE. Repentance is changing how you previously thought and did things that led you into sin. People can do the first two steps, BUT forget this one. As a result, they fall back into the VERY sin they asked God to forgive them for. Ask God to convict you. Avoid the sources of temptations. This calls for discipline. Read 1 Thess. 5:22 & James 4:7.

REFLECTION + SCRIPTURE

The 3-Step Process is something I created. You just make sure you approach God in humility, brokenness, and contrition about your sins, acknowledge and confess your sins, and ask for God's forgiveness. If you do this, He WILL forgive you. Also, asking for forgiveness is NOT a one time thing. I still do this. Read James 4:8-10, God bless!
