#### (Vine's Expository Dictionary)

"understanding, prudence" i.e., a right use of phren, "the mind", is translated "wisdom" in **Luke 1:17**. See **PRUDENCE**.

Note: "While **sophia** is the insight into the true nature of things, **phronesis** is the ability to discern modes of action with a view to their results; while sophia is theoretical, phronesis is "practical" (lightfoot). **Sunesis**, "understanding, intelligence," is the critical faculty; this and phronesis are particular applications of Sophia.

"Obviously no one English word will cover all these different uses, but the general meaning is clear enough-"the art of reaching one's end by the use of the right means".

Prudence, Prudent phronēsis [G5428]

"akin to phroneo, 'to have understanding' (phren, the mind), denoted 'practical wisdom, prudence in the management of affairs.' It is translated 'wisdom' in Luke 1:17, 'prudence' in Ephesians 1:8.

ḥākmâ [H2451]: shrewdness and prudence

**bînâ** [**H998**] "discernment"

"marked by clever **discerning awareness** and hardheaded keenness and **depth of perception**, discernment, or discrimination especially in practical matters."



Note: Discernment is the ability to make good judgment. In terms of The Faith, it is The Holy-Spirit-given ability to judge if someone or something is wicked or righteous. It is WISE for a believer to ask The I AM for discernment, so they are NOT deceived!







Luke 1:17, "And he shall go before him in the spirit and power of Elias, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord." KJV Version.

**phronēsis** [**G5428**]: "knowledge and holy love of the will of God"

Note: Let's put this definition into the scripture to gain understanding, shall we? What is the "wisdom of the just"? The "wisdom of the just" is the knowledge and holy love of the will of God.



"Who is the Just?" The Just are people "whose way of thinking, feeling, and acting is wholly conformed to the will of God, and who therefore need no rectification in the hearts or life" [dikaios G1342] or, in short, those who are right with The I AM.

perisseuō [G4052]: "to exceed a fixed number of measure, to be left over and above a certain number or measure"; "to abound, overflow"; "to excel more than, exceed"





This Greek word is presented in Ephesians 1:8 and Luke 1:17.

I desire clever discerning awareness and hardheaded acumen (which is keenness and depth of perception aka discernment).
