The Defilement of The Heart

MATTHEW 15:17-20 KJV

Matthew 15:17-20

"Do not ye yet understand, that whatsoever entereth in at the mouth goeth into the belly, and is cast out into the drought? (18) But those things which proceed out of the mouth come forth from the HEART; and they DEFILE the man. (19) For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies. (20) These are the things which DEFILE a man: but to eat with unwashen hands defileth not man." KJV Version.

What Does "Defile" mean?

[G2840] Koinoo

I. to make common

A. to make (Levitically) unclean, render, unhallowed defile, profane

B. to declare or count unclean

Strong's definition to make (or consider) profane (ceremonially):--call common, defile, pollute, unclean.

What Does "Defile" mean?

Vine's Expository Dictionary of New Testament Words:

[**G2840**] Koinoo

(a) "to make common"; hence, in a ceremonial sense, "to render unholy, unclean, to defile,"

(b) "to count unclean"

What Does "Defile" mean?

[G3392] Miaino

primarily, "to stain, to tinge or dye with another color, "as in the staining of a glass, hence, "to pollute, contaminate, soil, defile", is used

- (a) of "ceremonial defilement"
- (b) of "moral defilement"; "of moral and physical defilement"

What Does "Defile" mean?

[G3435] Moluno

properly denotes "to besmear", as with mud or filth, "to **befoul**". It is used in the figurative sense, of *a conscience "defiled" by sin*, *1 Corinthians 8:7*; of believers who have kept themselves (their "garments") from "defilement", *Rev 3:4*, and those who have **not "soiled" themselves by adultery or fornication**, *Rev 14:4*.

What Does "Defile" mean?

[G4695] Spiloo

"to make a stain or spot", and so "to defile", is used in James 3:6 of the "defiling" effects of an evil use of the tongue; in Jude 1:23, "spotted", with reference to moral "defilement".

• Spilos, "a spot", a moral blemish

What Does "Defile" mean?

[**G5351**] Phtherio

see **CORRUPT**

[**G5351**] Phtherio

signifies "to destroy by means of corrupting" and so "bringing into a worse state";

(a) with this significance it is used of the effect of evil company upon the manners of believers, and so of the effect of association with those who deny the Swipe

What Does "Defile" mean?

truth and hold false doctrine, 1 Corinthians 15:33 (this was a saying of the pagan poet Menander, which became a well known proverb); in 2 Corinthians 7:2, of the effects of dishonorable dealing by bringing people to want (a charge made against the Apostle); in 2 Corinthians 11:3, of the effects upon the minds (or thoughts) of believers by "corrupting"

What Does "Defile" mean?

them "from the simplicity and the purity that is toward Christ"; in Ephesians 4:22, intransitively, or the old nature in waxing "corrupt", "morally decaying, on the way to final ruin" (Moule), "after the lusts of deceit;" in Rev 19:2, metaphorically, of the Babylonish harlot, in "corrupting" the inhabitants of the earth by her false religion.

What Does "Defile" mean?

(b) With the significance of destroying, it is used of marring a local church by leading it away from that condition of holiness of life and purity of doctrine in which it should abide, 1 Corinthians 3:17 (AV, 'defile'), and of God's retributive destruction of the offender who is guilty of this sin (id.); of the effects of the work of false and abominable teachers upon themselves, 2 Peter 2:12 (some texts swipe

What Does "Defile" mean?

have kataphtheiro; AV, "shall utterly perish"), and Jude 1:10 (AV, "corrupt themselves." RV, marg., "are corrupted"). See **DEFILE** and **DESTROY**.

The Heart

Jeremiah 17:9, "The heart is deceitful above ALL things, and DESPERATELY wicked: who can know it?" KJV Version.

What is the heart? [G2588] Kardia "the soul or mind, as it is the fountain and seat of the thoughts, passions, desires, appetites, affections, purposes, endeavours."

The Heart

This means my thoughts; passions; desires; appetites; affections; purposes; and endeavors are *deceitful & wicked*.

This means my innate nature is what? Wicked & Deceitful.

What can **PURIFY** my heart? What can **PURGE** my filthiness? What can **CLEAN** my heart?

Purification

The **Blood** of Jesus Christ & The Washing of **The Word**.

Titus 2:14, "who [willingly] gave Himself [to be crucified] on our behalf to redeem us and purchase our freedom from ALL wickedness, and to purify for Himself a chosen and very special people to be His own possession, who are enthusiastic for doing what is good." AMP Version.

The Importance 15 of Repentance

[G3340] Metanoeo

I. "to *change* one's mind, i.e. to repent"
II. "to change one's mind *for better*,
heartily to amend with *abhorrence of one's past sins*"

We have to change and renew our minds because they're *desperately* what? *Wicked*.

We needs minds like Christ. Pure thoughts.

Pure passions. Pure desires.

The Importance 16 of Repentance

Pure appetites. Pure affections. Pure purposes. Pure endeavors.

Romans 12:2, "And do not be conformed to this world [any longer with its superficial values and customs], but be transformed and progressively changed [as you mature spiritually] by the renewing of your mind [focusing on godly values and ethical attitudes], so that you may prove [for yourselves] what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and Swipe

perfect [in His plan and purpose for you]." AMP Version.

"focusing on godly values and ethical attitudes"

How do we do that?

Well, you have to **STUDY** the **CHARACTER** of The I AM.

How do we do that?

Digest The Word of God. Learn about Swipe

The Importance 18 of Repentance

Your Savior. *KNOW* who He is! This is intimacy. Intimacy [H3045 yāḍa] means "to know". He will *reveal* Himself to those who *diligently* seek Him.

Ephesians 5:26, "so that He might sanctify the church, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word [of God]" AMP Version.

What will sanctify and clean The Church?

The Word.

The Importance 19 of Repentance

No matter what man's intentions, purposes, or desires are, we are *innately* wicked. DESPARATELY WICKED, at that!

We need *The Purifier and Sanctifier*, Jesus Christ, to cleanse us and wash us from *ALL* unrighteousness!

The Seeds In Our Hearts

Proverbs 4:23, "Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life." KJV Version. [Remember what "heart" (Kardia G2588) means?]

The eyes and ears are the gateways into the gardens of your heart. What we watch and listen to are SEEDS being planted into the garden of our hearts. If we continue to watch and listen to wicked things, the seed will be watered. Then, it will take root. Then, shoot.

& Finally, it will bear fruit in our lives.

The Seeds In Our Hearts

I wanted to touch on "The Seeds In Our Hearts" because this plays a part in our purification and sanctification.

We can do all the reading and praying we want, but if we don't bear righteous fruit, the heart will still be defiled. Take The Word (The Seed) and implant it in the garden of your heart.

Water your garden by continuing in The Word.

James 1:22-24, "But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. (23) For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: (24) For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was." KJV Version.

What This Reminds Me Of

The Parable of The Sower (Matthew 13:18-23). Remember I said you can do all the reading you want? It's important to get understanding, when reading The Word. This is how you apply it to your life. As Christ stated in verse 19, "When any one heareth the word of the kingdom, and understandeth it not, then cometh the wicked one, and catcheth away that which was sown in his heart. This is he which received seed by the way side." KJV Version. Swipe

What This 24 Reminds Me Of

Ask The Holy Spirit for understanding, when digesting The Word, so the righteous seeds that are being implanted in your garden will take *root*, *shoot*, and bear *fruit* in your life...but what type of fruit?

The Fruit of The Spirit [Galatians 5:22-23]!
