What The Most High Wants Out of You

A Faithful-Enduring Steward

Longsuffering, which is **patience** and **endurance**, is supposed to be evident in your life. The Most High never promised an easy road. In fact, He promised the **COMPLETE** opposite. In **John 16:33**, Christ said, "These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. **In the world ye shall have tribulation**: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world." **KJV Version.**

You're A Child of God. Expect Resistance.

A Faithful-Enduring Steward

The moment you decided to **submit** your life to Christ, there was a **target** on your back. The enemy (Satan) comes to **steal, kill, and destroy (John 10:10)** that **faith** of yours. This is a given; however,

Christ gave us the solution: **worship, The Word, and prayer.**

Worship makes you joyful. The I AM used The Word **against the enemy** in Matthew 4. The Most High also told us to pray **WITHOUT** ceasing. With these, we renew our strength.

Let's Read The Word Together

A Faithful-Enduring Steward

Romans 12:12, "Be joyful because you have hope [Rejoice in hope]. **Be patient [Endure] when trouble comes [in suffering/tribulation]**, and pray at all times [**faithfully; with persistence/perseverance**]." **EXB Version**. We are sons of God. **Our hope is eternal salvation with The I AM**. This is something to be joyful about! When resistance or suffering comes, we are supposed to **ENDURE** because trouble **WON'T** last always!

A Man After The Most High's Heart

A Faithful-Enduring Steward

What's a keyword in the previous verse? That's right: **perseverance**. You are not supposed to allow the troubles of this world or attacks of the enemy keep you from praying to The Most High. When you're being attacked, **prayer and worship are your weapons**. Just read about **David** (especially in the Book of Psalm). He was constantly worshipping and praying to The Most High. He is a perfect example of **A Faithful-Enduring Steward**.

Encourage Yourself In The Word

Let me bring up one of David's admirable moments: **1 Samuel 30:6**, "And David was greatly distressed...**but David encouraged himself in the LORD his God.**" **KJV Version** (read the chapter for context). When David was **GREATLY** distressed, did he stop seeking The Most High? Did he quit? No, David was **faithful** to The Most High. He **endured** when trouble came. He **ENCOURAGED** himself in The I AM. He **persevered**. We are expected to do the same.

Reality Check

A Faithful-Enduring Steward

If you allow the attacks, sufferings, and disappointments **stop** you from reading The Word, worshipping, or praying to The Most High, **you're not A Faithful-Enduring Steward**. Listen, this whole post was birthed out of **the boulder of conviction, The Holy Spirit catapulted into my heart**. He called me out too. He wants **FAITHFUL-ENDURING STEWARDS**. We are in the End Times. **We HAVE to prepare ourselves for the tribulation to come.**

What To Pray For

A Faithful-Enduring Steward

Love, Joy & Peace are **beautiful fruits** of the Spirit; **however**, let's tackle these two fruits: **longsuffering and faith**. How can The Most High use us in the End Times, when we can't even get over the **MINOR** sufferings and attacks in this present time? **We can't even be faithful to Him or even endure now**. Oh, how the Antichrist will have fun with some of us! Ask The Most High to test you on your faith and patience. Ask Him to help you be **FERVENT** in prayer and **JOYFUL** in your sufferings.
